<u>VILLAGE DEPARTMENT OF PUBL</u>IC WORKS & SNOW REMOVAL

To provide you with the best service possible, the Department of Public Works (DPW) would like to remind everyone that your cooperation is needed during the winter months for proper plowing, salting and snow removal. If you have a driveway or an off street parking space, please use it during the winter months and especially during a snow or ice storm as vehicles parked on the street hinder plowing operations. Please do not put snow in the streets once the plows have gone through. Additionally, anything that you might have in the Village's right-of-way, such as a basketball hoop, should be moved and stored for the winter. The Village will not be responsible for damage to any items left in the Village's right-of-way. In the event that a snow emergency is declared, details will be provided to local news stations, on the Village website and through our emergency alert system.

DUMPSTER RESERVATIONS BEGIN APRIL 1ST

Beginning April 1st - there will be a \$75.00 charge for the dumpster. To make a reservation for the dumpster, you need to come to the Village Office (8 a.m. - 4 p.m.), we can not take calls for reservations. Payment of \$75.00 will be due at time of making your reservation - No contractor's debris will be accepted. The Village crew will leave the dumpster at the end of your driveway on a Wednesday and pick it up the following Wednesday. Mark your calendar for March 29 to stop in the Village Office to schedule the dumpster starting April 1st.

NYS ADOPT-A-HIGHWAY PROGRAM

NYS Adopt-A-Highway Program - Van Rensselaer Blvd Across the country, thousands of communities have signaled their commitment to keeping America beautiful by adopting stretches of highway and pledging to keep them litter-free. Approximately 5,000 miles of New York State highway roadsides are adopted. The New York State Department of 2,400 active Transportation has Adopt-A-Highway place. agreements in Volunteer groups, organizations, businesses or individuals may adopt a segment of highway as long as there are no other adopters of that segment. NYSDOT must determine that the segment to be adopted is safe for voluntary beautification. The adopters agree to perform at least four pick-ups each year, and the NYSDOT will collect and properly dispose of the litter the adopters have collected.

Menands School Kindergarten Registration for the 2019-2020 School Year

The Menands School District has begun the process of registering students for the 2019-2020 Kindergarten Class. If you, or someone you know, has a child who will be 5 years of age on or before December 1, 2019 please contact the district registrar at 518-465-4561 ext. 100. Registration paperwork can be printed from the school's web page (www.menands.org) or picked up in person anytime Monday through Friday from 8-4. New York State Public Health Law, Section 2164, requires certain immunizations to enter kindergarten and attend school. Please check with your health care provider as soon as possible to make sure your child has all the needed immunizations. A copy of your child's immunization record and his/her current physical must be submitted prior to the first day of school in order to attend kindergarten.
