The front door said I was unhinged, and so the curtains told me to...yes, you guessed it.... pull myself together.

#### TEN REMARKABLE CLEANING SOLUTIONS

#### Miracle Stain Remover

Mix 2/3 cup blue Dawn, 2/3 c ammonia, 6 T baking soda and 2 c warm water into a spray bottle.

Spray on stain and let sit for a few minutes. Wash as usual and watch stain vanish!

#### Super Shower Cleaner

Mix equal parts white vinegar & blue Dawn in a spray bottle.

Spray all over shower, let sit for 2 hours. Wipe clean, goodbye scum & rust!

#### Clean Glass Showers

Slice a lemon in half and dip into a bowl of kosher salt, start scrubbing! The citric and salt combination combats pesky shower scum!

## Dirty Oven Racks

Soak oven racks in bathtub with hot water, 8 dryer sheets (any brand) & ½ cup of blue Dawn overnight. Watch build up fall right off! Use dryer sheets to remove any remaining build up.

### The Better Oxy-Cleaner

Mix ½ c hydrogen peroxide, ½ c super washing soda & 1 cup hot water.

Soak laundry in this mixture overnight to erase impossible stains.

#### Wrinkle Release Spray

Mix equal parts fabric softener, white vinegar, and water in a spray bottle.

Spray on fabric and pull slightly, watch wrinkles straighten right out.! You can also put fabric in the dryer after spraying for the same result.

#### Ink Stains

Apply a squirt of Purell to the stain, let sit for 10 minutes.

Wash as usual.

#### Carpet Stain Remover

Mix equal parts ammonia and hot water.

Pour mixture over stain and cover with a clean white towel.

Iron the towel ontop of the stain. Watch the stain instantly lift from the rug.

#### Magic Dishwasher Cleaner

Place a cup of white vinegar on the top rack of your empty dishwasher, run a hot cycle (note: make sure to check the trap for any blockage first!

When cycle is complete sprinkle baking soda on the bottom of the dishwasher, run another short cycle.

Your dishwasher smells fresh and clean.

## Remove Armpit Stains

Mix one-part blue Dawn with two parts hydrogen peroxide'

Pour mixture over stain and let sit for one hour. You may add baking soda and scrub lightly for extra pesky stains. Wash as usual. Stains will be gone like magic.
