SIMMONS MACHINE TOOL CORPORATION

NSH USA

Founded in 1910 and based in Menands, New York, the Simmons Machine Tool Corporation is the oldest continuing business in the Village of Menands. Simmons (NSH USA) is a leading manufacturer of specialized machine tools for, "railway wheel set maintenance and production worldwide." Throughout its history, the company has built machine tools for a range of industries including weapons manufacturing, ship building and railway. The NSH Group has production facilities in the United States, Germany and China as well as technical sales service offices in Germany, Australia, China, Russia, India, Mexico and South Africa. Today, the company's President and COO is David William Davis, while the chairman and owner is Hans J. Naumann, with John O. Naumann acting as CEO. In January of 2023 Simmons (NSH USA) announced it was expanding their Machine tool manufacturer NSH USA Corp. has revised previously announced plans for a multimillion-dollar expansion at its Menands complex in light of increasing demand for its products. Rather than build a 25,000- to 30,000-square-foot showroom aimed at domestic customers, the company instead is advancing plans for a new manufacturing/assembly building at its 6.2-acre campus on Broadway, where it currently has 120 employees. "Our new assembly building is an investment in NSH USA and our future, but also an investment in the future of manufacturing in New York's Capital Region and the talented people that drive the area's manufacturing renaissance," said Davis, who cited the company's longstanding ties to Hudson Valley Community College as a key factor in its growth. The estimated total cost for the project is \$8 million. NSH USA is a subsidiary of The NSH Group, one of the world's largest machine tool manufacturers.
