PASSING A SCHOOL BUS

School is now in session, so please be cautious and keep an eye out for children. In New York State, passing a stopped school bus illegally, particularly when the red lights are flashing, comes with serious consequences. This can include fines between \$250 and \$1,000, possible jail time (up to 30 days for a first offense and up to 180 days for repeat offenses within three years), and points added to your driver's license. According to New York State law, drivers must stop from both directions when a school bus has its red lights flashing and its stop arm is extended. PLEASE be careful!

ADA COMPLIANCE

The Village of Menands and the Capital District Transportation Council have completed a Self-Analysis and Transition Plan for pedestrian facilities, which are an example of a local government program, service, or activity under the Americans with Disabilities Act. The Self-Analysis outlines the accessibility of existing pedestrian infrastructure. The study was completed by walking every street within the Village of Menands. Along with the sidewalks, the Village is looking to improve access to 250 Broadway to make the building ADA compliant. A copy of the study is available in the Village Office and on the Village Website.
